The School Health Service (Amendment) Regulations 1968

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3(4) of the Local Government Act 1958(a), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the School Health Service (Amendment) Regulations 1968 and shall come into operation on 19th August 1968.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of regulations

2. In regulation 5A of the School Health Service Regulations 1959(c) as amended (d), after the word “physiotherapist” there shall be inserted the word “orthoptist”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
