TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

The Redundancy Fund Increase of Contributions Order 1968

Laid before Parliament in draft Made - - - 2nd August 1968 Coming into Operation 2nd September 1968

The Secretary of State with the consent of the Treasury in exercise of her powers under section 27(3) of the Redundancy Payments Act 1965(a) and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf hereby makes the following Order, a draft of which has been laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Redundancy Fund Increase of Contributions Order 1968 and shall come into operation on the 2nd September 1968.

(2) The Redundancy Fund Contributions Order 1966(b) is hereby revoked.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if this Order and the Order hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.

3. In respect of any contribution week beginning on or after 2nd September 1968 section 27(2) of the Redundancy Payments Act 1965 shall have effect as if for the sums therein specified there were substituted respectively the sum of one shilling and threepence in the case of a man and of sevenpence in the case of a woman.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order which comes into operation on 2nd September 1968 increases the weekly redundancy fund contributions from tenpence to one shilling and threepence in the case of a man and from fivepence to sevenpence in the case of a woman.
