**The Rent Book (Forms of Notice) (Scotland)
Regulations 1968**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 14 as read with section 15 of the Rent and Mortgage Interest Restrictions (Amendment) Act 1933(a), section 12(6) as read with section 26(1) of, and paragraph 19 of Schedule 6 to, the Rent Act 1957(b), and section 19(1) of the Housing (Financial Provisions, &c.) (Scotland) Act 1967(c), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rent Book (Forms of Notice) (Scotland) Regulations 1968 and shall come into operation on 1st March 1968.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d), shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Regulation 5 of, and Part III of the Schedule to, the Rent Book (Forms of Notice) (Scotland) Regulations 1965(e), as set out in the said regulations, shall have effect from 1st March 1968.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations make it obligatory from 1st March 1968 to insert a notice on the lines set out in Part III of the Schedule to the Rent Books (Forms of Notice) (Scotland) Regulations 1965, in every rent book or similar document used by or on behalf of a landlord in respect of a furnished house on a weekly let to which the Rent of Furnished Houses Control (Scotland) Act 1943 applied immediately before the coming into operation of the Rent Act 1965 (8th December 1965) or to which the said Act of 1943 applies by virtue of the Rent Act 1965.
