HIRE PURCHASE

The Control of Hiring (Amendment No. 9) Order 1968

Made - - - - 31st October 1968
Laid before Parliament 1st November 1968
Coming into Operation 2nd November 1968

The Board of Trade in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1 and 22 (3) of the Emergency Laws (Re-enactments and Repeals) Act 1964(a) hereby order as follows:—

- 1. The Control of Hiring Order 1964(b), as amended(c), shall have effect in relation to an agreement to let goods on hire entered into on or after 2nd November 1968 subject to the following amendments:
 - (a) in Article 8, for the references therein to goods of any of the descriptions specified in items 6 and 7 there shall be substituted references to goods of the description specified in item 6; and
 - (b) for Schedule 1 to the said Order there shall be substituted the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Control of Hiring (Amendment No. 9) Order 1968 and shall come into operation on 2nd November 1968.

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Control of Hiring Order 1964, as amended. The rentals or charges which have to be paid before a hiring agreement is entered into are increased in the case of all goods to which the Order applies except photographic equipment. The rentals or charges in the case of goods other than motor vehicles are those payable in respect of the first 42 weeks instead of the first 30 weeks, in the case of motor vehicles with more than three wheels those payable in respect of the first 42 weeks instead of the first 36 weeks and in the case of motor vehicles with less than four wheels those payable in respect of the first 36 weeks instead of the first 26 weeks.
