EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) Order 1968

Made - - - - 15th February 1968

Coming into Operation 16th February 1968

Whereas—

(1) in pursuance of section 2(2) of the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965(a) (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) the Committee constituted under section 1 of the Act for the purpose of considering the remuneration of teachers in establishments for further education (other than farm institutes) maintained by local education authorities (hereinafter referred to as “the Committee”) transmitted to the Secretary of State for Education and Science (hereinafter referred to as “the Secretary of State”) certain recommendations agreed on by them with respect to the remuneration of such teachers;

(2) in pursuance of section 3(1) of the Act certain other matters in respect of which agreement had not been reached in the Committee were referred to arbitration;

(3) in pursuance of section 2(3) and 4(1) of the Act, the Secretary of State prepared a draft document setting out the scales and other provisions required for determining the remuneration of teachers of the description aforesaid in the form in which, in his opinion, those scales and provisions should be so as to give effect to the recommendations of the Committee and of the arbitrators;

(4) the Secretary of State, as required by section 2(4) of the Act, consulted the Committee with respect to the draft document and made such modifications thereof as were requisite for giving effect to representations made by the Committee; and

(5) the Secretary of State has arranged for a document setting out the requisite scales and other provisions in the form of the draft as modified as aforesaid to be published by Her Majesty’s Stationery Office under the title “SCALES OF SALARIES FOR TEACHERS IN ESTABLISHMENTS FOR FURTHER EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES, 1967”.

Now therefore the Secretary of State, in pursuance of sections 2(4) and 4(1) of the Act, hereby orders as follows:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) Order 1968 and shall come into operation on 16th February 1968.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(a) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Remuneration of Teachers

3. The remuneration payable from 1st July 1967 to full-time teachers in establishments for further education (other than farm institutes) maintained by local education authorities shall be determined in accordance with the scales and other provisions set out in the document published by Her Majesty's Stationery Office as aforesaid.

Revocation

4. The Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) Order 1965(b) is hereby revoked and section 38(2) of the Interpretation Act 1889 (which relates to the effect of repeals) shall have effect in relation to that Order as if it were an enactment repealed by an Act.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation the scales and other provisions relating to the remuneration of full-time teachers in establishments for further education (other than farm institutes) maintained by local education authorities contained in a document published by Her Majesty's Stationery Office. This document gives effect both to agreed recommendations made by the Committee for the consideration of the remuneration of such teachers and, subject to certain modifications agreed by the Committee, to an arbitration award.

Clause 3 provides that the Order shall have effect in relation to full-time teachers from 1st July 1967; this provision is made in exercise of the power conferred by section 7(3) of the Act.
