## AGRICULTURAL AND HORTICULTURAL MARKETING

The Market Development Scheme (Extension of Period)  
Order 1968

*Made* - - - 20th February 1968

*Laid before Parliament* 28th February 1968

*Coming into Operation* 27th March 1968

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 9(6) of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1963(a), hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Market Development Scheme (Extension of Period) Order 1968; and shall come into operation on the day after it has been approved by resolution of each House of Parliament.

2. The period during which approvals may be given under section 9 of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1963 (which relates to schemes for the payment of grants for the promotion of efficient marketing of agricultural and horticultural produce) was extended until the end of March 1968 by the Market Development Scheme (Extension of Period) Order 1965(b) and that period as so extended is hereby further extended until the end of March 1971.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the order.)*

The Market Development Scheme (Extension of Period) Order 1965 extended by three years, ending on 31st March 1968 the period during which approvals may be given by the appropriate Minister under section 9 of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1963. This order further extends such period by three years, ending on 31st March 1971. These approvals relate to proposals under the Market Development Scheme 1964 (S.I. 1964/456) and any other such scheme under that section for grant-aiding the promotion of efficient marketing of agricultural and horticultural produce.

In accordance with section 9(10) of the Act, this order was approved by a resolution of the House of Commons on 26th March 1968 and a resolution of the House of Lords on 26th March 1968.
