The Provision of Milk and Meals Amending Regulations 1968

<i>Made</i> -	1st April 1968
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	9th April 1968

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 49 of the Education Act 1944(a) as amended by the Secretary of State for Education and Science Order 1964(b) and section 3 of the Public Expenditure and Receipts Act 1968(c), hereby makes the following regulations :—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Provision of Milk and Meals Amending Regulations 1968 and shall come into operation on 10th April 1968.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of regulations

2.—(1) The Provision of Milk and Meals Regulations 1945(e) as amended(f) shall have effect subject to the substitution for the proviso to regulation 8 (remission of charge for school dinner) of the following proviso :

“ Provided that the parent shall be entitled to remission of the charge in accordance with approved arrangements—

(a) if he is unable to pay it without financial hardship ; and

(b) in respect of any child of a family which includes three other dependent children under 19 in respect of whom the charge is not remitted under this subparagraph.”

(2) As respects any school paragraph (1) shall not take effect until the beginning of the summer term 1968.
