The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue of the powers conferred upon Her by section 5 of the West Indies Act 1962(a) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Turks and Caicos Islands Citation, (Constitution) (Amendment) Order 1968 and shall be construed as construction one with the Turks and Caicos Islands Constitution Orders 1965 and and com-1967(b).

mencement

- (2) The Turks and Caicos Islands Constitution Orders 1965 and 1967 and this Order may be cited together as the Turks and Caicos Islands Constitution Orders 1965 to 1968.
  - (3) This Order shall come into operation on 15th May 1968.
- 2. Section 19 of the Constitution of the Turks and Caicos Islands Amendment set out in Schedule 1 to the Turks and Caicos Islands (Constitution) of section 19 Order 1965(c) shall have effect, and shall be deemed to have had effect of Constitution of Turks as from the coming into operation of that Order, as if the words and Caicos "twenty-years or upwards" in paragraph (a) thereof were "twenty-one Islands. years or upwards".
