**The Turks and Caicos Islands (Constitution)
(Amendment) Order 1968**

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 8th day of May 1968

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue of the powers conferred upon Her by section 5 of the West Indies Act 1962(a) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Turks and Caicos Islands (Constitution) (Amendment) Order 1968 and shall be construed as one with the Turks and Caicos Islands Constitution Orders 1965 and 1967(b). Citation, construction and commencement.

(2) The Turks and Caicos Islands Constitution Orders 1965 and 1967 and this Order may be cited together as the Turks and Caicos Islands Constitution Orders 1965 to 1968.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 15th May 1968.

2. Section 19 of the Constitution of the Turks and Caicos Islands set out in Schedule 1 to the Turks and Caicos Islands (Constitution) Order 1965(c) shall have effect, and shall be deemed to have had effect as from the coming into operation of that Order, as if the words "twenty-years or upwards" in paragraph (a) thereof were "twenty-one years or upwards". Amendment of section 19 of Constitution of Turks and Caicos Islands.

This Order amends with retrospective effect the provision in the Constitution of the Turks and Caicos Islands regarding the age qualification for election to the Legislative Assembly.
