BUILDING AND BUILDINGS**The Building Control (Cost Limit Exemption) (Revocation) Order 1968**

The Minister of Public Building and Works, in exercise of his powers under section 8 of the Building Control Act 1966(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The Building Control (Cost Limit Exemption) Order 1966(b) is hereby revoked.

2.—(1) Section 38 of the Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply as if this Order were an Act of Parliament and as if the Order revoked by this Order were an Act of Parliament repealed by an Act of Parliament.

(2) This Order may be cited as the Building Control (Cost Limit Exemption) (Revocation) Order 1968 and shall come into operation on 23rd May 1968.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order revokes the Building Control (Cost Limit Exemption) Order 1966 (which reduces the cost limit exemption specified in section 2(1) of the Building Control Act 1966 from £100,000 to £50,000) and accordingly has the effect of restoring the exemption limit to £100,000.
