The Gaming Act (Registration under Part III) (Scotland) Regulations 1969

Laid before Parliament	11th August 1969

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 51 of the Gaming Act 1968(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with the Gaming Board for Great Britain, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Gaming Act (Registration under Part III) (Scotland) Regulations 1969 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1969.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) applies for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) In these regulations, "the Act" means the Gaming Act 1968.

2.—(1) An application for registration, renewal of registration or cancellation of registration under Part III of the Act shall be made in writing, in the appropriate form set out in Schedule 1 to these regulations, by lodging the application with the sheriff clerk for the county or other area in which the relevant premises are situated.

(2) A certificate of registration or renewal of registration under Part III of the Act shall be in the appropriate form set out in Schedule 2 to these regulations.

(3) The register to be kept under paragraph 2 of Schedule 10 to the Act for the purposes of registration under Part III of the Act shall be in the form set out in Schedule 3 to these regulations.

(4) The prescribed fee for the purposes of paragraph 4 of Schedule 10 to the Act shall be five shillings.

(5) Any reference in this regulation to a form includes a reference to a form to the like effect with any variations which the circumstances may require.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations relate to the machinery of registration under Part III of the Gaming Act 1968, which enables a members' club or miners' welfare institute to register its premises so as to permit the use there of two gaming machines.

The Regulations come into operation on 1st October 1969 to allow time for registration before Part III of the Act comes into effective operation on 1st July 1970.
