**The Local Review Committee (Scotland) (Amendment)
Rules 1969**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	20th August 1969
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	15th September 1969
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	17th November 1969

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 59(6) of the Criminal Justice Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following rules:—

1.—(1) These rules may be cited as the Local Review Committee (Scotland) (Amendment) Rules 1969 and shall come into operation on 17th November 1969.

(2) In these rules the expression “the principal rules” means the Local Review Committee (Scotland) Rules 1967(b).

2. The principal rules shall be amended as follows:—

(a) For rule 3(2) there shall be substituted the following:—

“(2) The committee shall consist of the governor of the prison and not less than two other members appointed by the Secretary of State and shall include among its members:—

(a) an officer of a local authority under the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968(c);

(b) a person who is not an officer of a local authority under the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 or a prison officer.

and no member of the committee other than the governor of the prison shall be a prison officer.”

(b) For rule 4(2) there shall be substituted the following:—

“(2) The review of a prisoner’s case shall be conducted at a special meeting of not fewer than three members, of whom one shall be the governor of the prison, one an officer of a local authority under the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 and one who is not an officer of a local authority under the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 or a prison officer.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

With the implementation of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 the term "probation officer" is no longer in use. These Rules carry into effect this change in terminology.
