The Import Duties (General) (No. 2) Order 1969

<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>1st October 1969</i>

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 1, 2 and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Board of Trade hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (General) (No. 2) Order 1969.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 1st October 1969.

2. In Schedule 1 to the Import Duties (General) (No. 4) Order 1968(c) (which Schedule by reference to the Customs Tariff 1959 sets out the import duties chargeable under the Import Duties Act 1958), in heading 02.01 (A)(1) (beef and veal), the following shall be substituted for sub-heading (a):—

“ (a) Boned or boneless	5%	C —	
		E	5%”

This Order reduces the full and E.F.T.A. rates of import duty on boned or boneless beef and veal from 20% to 5% ad valorem.
