The Teachers (Education, Training and Registration) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1969

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 7(1) of the Teaching Council (Scotland) Act 1965(a) and by section 144(1) and (5) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1962(b) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, after affording under the provisions of section 7(5) of the said Act of 1965 the General Teaching Council an opportunity of considering a draft of these regulations and no representations having been made by the Council and after causing a draft thereof to be published and a copy sent to every education authority and having regard to the representations made, in accordance with the provisions of section 144(2) of the said Act of 1962 and section 7(8) of the said Act of 1965, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the Teachers (Education, Training and Registration) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1969, shall be read as one with the Teachers (Education, Training and Registration) (Scotland) Regulations 1967(c) (hereinafter referred to as the "principal regulations") and shall come into operation on 1st August 1970.

Amendment of Schedule 1 to the principal regulations

- 2. In paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the principal regulations—
- (1) for sub-paragraph (1) (e) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph:—
 - "(e) in the case of a candidate who holds a Master's (foreign-going) Certificate of Competency of the Board of Trade, passes on the Ordinary grade in English and in mathematics only shall be required;".
- (2) after sub-paragraph (1) (f) there shall be inserted the following sub-paragraph:—
 - "(g) in the case of a candidate seeking a teaching qualification in technical subjects, the said sub-paragraph (5) shall not apply and he shall be required to hold:—
 - (i) passes in at least 6 subjects including English, mathematics and either a
 technical subject or engineering science, at least 2 of the passes to be on
 the Higher grade and to include a pass in mathematics or physics or
 engineering science;

- (ii) passes in at least 5 subjects including English, mathematics and either a technical subject or engineering science, at least 3 of the passes to be on the Higher grade and to include a pass in mathematics or physics or engineering science; or
- (iii) passes in at least 4 subjects on the Higher grade, including—
 - (a) English;
 - (b) mathematics or physics or engineering science; and
 - (c) a technical subject or, if not already offered under (b), engineering science; or
- (iv) (a) three years' industrial experience approved by the governing body;
 - (b) passes in English and mathematics on the Ordinary grade; and
 - (c) a technical qualification approved by the Secretary of State after consultation with the Council:

Provided that if during the period between 1st August 1970 and 1st August 1972 a candidate is unable to satisfy the requirements of head (g) of this subparagraph the provisions thereof may be dispensed with if he can satisfy the other requirements of sub-paragraph (1) of this paragraph; and".

This amendment to the Teachers (Education, Training and Registration) (Scotland) Regulations 1967 prescribes revised requirements governing admission to a course of training at a college of education leading to the award by the college of a Teaching Qualification (Secondary Education) in Technical Subjects.
