The County Court Districts (Wisbech and March) Order 1969

Made - - - 25th September 1969

Coming into Operation 20th October 1969

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the County Courts Act 1959(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the County Court Districts (Wisbech and March) Order 1969 and shall come into operation on 20th October 1969.

(2) The County Court Districts Order 1949(b), as amended (c), shall have effect as further amended by this Order.

2.—(1) The districts of the Wisbech and March County Courts shall be consolidated and a court shall be held for the consolidated district at March, under the name of the Wisbech and March County Court:

Provided that no process shall be invalid if the court is described therein as the Wisbech County Court or the March County Court.

(2) The Wisbech and March County Court shall have jurisdiction in proceedings commenced in the Wisbech County Court or the March County Court before this Order comes into operation.
