Act of Sederunt (Sessions of Court Amendment) 1969

<i>Made</i>	- - -	24th October 1969
<i>Coming into Operation</i>		1st January 1970

The Lords of Council and Session, by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1948(a), do hereby enact and declare as follows:—

1. The Act of Sederunt (Sessions of Court) 1969(b) is hereby repealed.
2. The Ordinary sessions of the Court of Session during 1970 shall be as follows:—

From Tuesday, 6th January to Thursday, 26th March;

From Tuesday, 28th April to Saturday, 18th July;

From Thursday, 1st October to Saturday, 19th December.

3. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Sessions of Court Amendment) 1969 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1970.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.
