FOREIGN COMPENSATION

The Foreign Compensation (Financial Provisions) Order 1969

Made	18th March 1969
Laid before Parliament	24th March 1969
Coming into Operation	25th March 1969

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 18th day of March 1969 Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in that behalf by section 7(2) of the Foreign Compensation Act 1950(a) and section 3(3) of the Foreign Compensation Act 1962(b) or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

- 1. The Foreign Compensation Commission shall pay into the Exchequer not later than 30th March 1969 out of each of the Funds named in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order the amount specified in respect of that Fund in column 2 of the Schedule which is hereby determined to be the amount of the expenses of the Commission during the period 1st October 1967 to 30th September 1968 attributable to the discharge by the Commission of their functions in relation to the distribution of sums from that Fund.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on 25th March 1969 and may be cited as the Foreign Compensation (Financial Provisions) Order 1969.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which is made under section 7(2) of the Foreign Compensation Act 1950 and section 3(3) of the Foreign Compensation Act 1962, directs the Foreign Compensation Commission to pay into the Exchequer, out of

sums paid to the Commission for the purpose of being distributed under the said Acts, amounts in respect of the Commission's expenses during the period 1st October 1967 to 30th September 1968 in relation to the distribution of those sums.
