## BETTING AND GAMING

## The Gaming Act 1968 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1969

Made . . . . . 28th March 1969

In pursuance of section 54(4) of the Gaming Act 1968(a), I hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Gaming Act 1968 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1969.

2. Section 27(6) of and Schedule 6 to the Gaming Act 1968 shall come into operation on 1st May 1969.

3. Subject, as regards section 27(6), to Article 2 of this Order, sections 26, 27, 28, 29, 38(1), (2) and (12) and (for the purposes of those subsections of section 38) 39(1) of the Gaming Act 1968 shall come into operation on 1st April 1970.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order brings into force, with effect from 1st April 1970, those provisions of the Gaming Act 1968 which prohibit, with certain exceptions, the supply or maintenance of slot-machines for playing games of chance by persons other than those who have obtained a certificate or permit from the Gaming Board for Great Britain.

Article 2 brings into force, with effect from 1st May 1969, the provisions for the grant of the necessary certificates and permits.

This Order also brings into force, with effect from 1st April 1970, those provisions of the Act which prohibit, with certain exceptions, the supply and maintenance of such machines on profit-sharing terms.
