The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 3) Order 1969

Made - - - 21st April 1969

Laid before the House of
Commons - - 25th April 1969

Coming into Operation 1st May 1969

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by section 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Board of Trade hereby make the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 3) Order 1969.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
 - (3) This Order shall come into operation on 1st May 1969.
- 2. Schedule 1 to the Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 1) Order 1969(c) (which lists the goods temporarily exempted from import duty by virtue of Article 2(1) of the Order, and contains an entry for certain goods of heading 29.08 of the Customs Tariff 1959) shall be amended by omitting from that entry "1,4-Di-(2-hydroxyethoxy)benzene".
