MINES AND QUARRIES

The Mines (Notification of Dangerous Occurrences) (Amendment) Order 1969

Made	14th July	1969
Laid before Parliament	23rd July	1969

Whereas the Minister of Power is of opinion that the special class of occurrences at mines which is hereinafter specified is of so dangerous a nature as to render it expedient that notice should be given under section 116 of the Mines and Quarries Act 1954(a) as modified by the Mines and Quarries (Tips) Act 1969(b) in every case thereof:

Now, therefore, the Minister in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by sections 117(1) and 173 of the Mines and Quarries Act 1954 and section 1 of and Schedule 1 to the Mines and Quarries (Tips) Act 1969 and of all other powers him enabling hereby orders as follows:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Mines (Notification of Dangerous Occurrences) (Amendment) Order 1969 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1969.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) applies for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if this Order and the Order hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.
- 2.—(1) The Mines (Notification of Dangerous Occurrences) Order 1959(d) shall have effect subject to the modifications specified in this article.
- (2) For sub-paragraph (t) of article 3 inserted by the Mines (Notification of Dangerous Occurrences) (Amendment) Order 1967(e) there shall be inserted the following sub-paragraph:—
 - "(t) any movement of material or any fire or any other event indicates that a tip to which Part I of the Mines and Quarries (Tips) Act 1969 applies is, or is likely to become, insecure."

and the Mines (Notification of Dangerous Occurrences) (Amendment) Order 1967 is accordingly hereby revoked.

(3) In article 4(1) after the words "in paragraph (e)" there shall be inserted the words "or (t)".
