The Fixed Penalty (Procedure) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 1970

Made--15th July 1970Laid before Parliament23rd July 1970Coming into Operation1st August 1970

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by section 80(11) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fixed Penalty (Procedure) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 1970.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
 - (3) These Regulations shall not extend to Scotland.
 - (4) These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st August 1970.
- 2.—(1) In Regulation 4(1)(a) of the Fixed Penalty (Procedure) Regulations 1970(c), as amended (d), after the words "the south-east London area" there shall be inserted the words "or the south-west London area".
 - (2) Regulation 4(1)(b) of the said Regulations shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations provide that payment of a fixed penalty for an offence committed in the south-west London area shall be made to the chief clerk at the Marylebone magistrates' court instead of to the clerk to the justices for the Kingston-upon-Thames petty sessional division.
