# The Cinematograph Films (Collection of Levy) (Amendment) Regulations 1970

Laid before Parliament in draft

Coming into Operation

4th October 1970

Whereas a draft of these Regulations has been laid before Parliament and approved by Resolution of each House pursuant to section 2(7) of the Cinematograph Films Act 1957(a), as amended and extended by the Films Act 1970(**b**);

Now, therefore, the Board of Trade in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the said Act of 1957, as so amended and extended, and after consultation with the Cinematograph Films Council, hereby make the following Regulations:-

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Cinematograph Films (Collection of Levy) (Amendment) Regulations 1970 and shall come into operation on 4th October 1970.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Cinematograph Films (Collection of Levy) Regulations 1968(d) shall have effect as if in Regulation 2 for the words "two consecutive periods" there were substituted the words "twelve consecutive periods".
