

**1970 No. 1358****TAXES****The Late Night Refreshment Houses (Variation of Duty)  
Order 1970**

In pursuance of section 3 of the Late Night Refreshment Houses Act 1969(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Late Night Refreshment Houses (Variation of Duty) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1971.

2. Section 3(1) of the Late Night Refreshment Houses Act 1969 (which specifies the duty chargeable on a licence under that Act) shall be amended by substituting for the words “one guinea” the words “six pounds”.

This Order increases the duty payable annually to the licensing authority in respect of a licence under the Late Night Refreshment Houses Act 1969 from £1 1s. (the amount originally fixed in 1860) to £6.
