**POLICE****The Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2)  
Regulations 1970**

*Made - - - - - 24th September 1970*  
*Laid before Parliament 30th September 1970*  
*Coming into Operation 1st October 1970*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 27 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consulting the Police Council for the United Kingdom in accordance with section 4(4) of the Police Act 1969(b), I hereby make the following regulations:—

*Citation*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1970.

*Interpretation*

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Police Cadets (Scotland) Regulations 1968(c), as amended (d).

*Operation and effect*

3.—(1) These regulations shall come into operation on 1st October 1970 and shall have effect:—

- (a) for the purposes of regulation 4 thereof, as from 1st July 1970 ;  
 (b) for the purposes of regulation 5 thereof, as from 1st October 1970.

*Pay*

4. For the Table in Schedule 1 to the principal regulations (which contains scales of pay) there shall be substituted the following Table:—

”

*Charge for board and lodging*

5. In Schedule 2 to the principal regulations (which relates to charges for board and lodging) there shall be substituted the sum of "£105" for the sum of "£96".

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations further amend the Police Cadets (Scotland) Regulations 1968.

Regulation 4 provides for increases in pay.

Regulation 5 increases charges for board and lodging by £9 a year.

By virtue of Regulation 3(1)(a) the increases in pay have effect from 1st July 1970. This is provided in exercise of the power conferred by section 27(2) of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967.
