Her Majesty, in pursuance of the power conferred upon Her by section 2(4) of the Anchors and Chain Cables Act 1967(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1. The Anchors and Chain Cables Act 1967 shall come into operation on 19th October 1970.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Anchors and Chain Cables Act 1967 (Commencement) Order 1970.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation on 19th October 1970 the Anchors and Chain Cables Act 1967, which repeals the Anchors and Chain Cables Act 1899. The 1899 Act made provision for the testing and marking of anchors and chain cables for use in British ships. The 1967 Act empowers the Board of Trade to make rules with respect to the testing and marking of anchors and chain cables for use in ships registered in the United Kingdom.
