**The Civil Aviation (Aerial Advertising) (Amendment)
Regulations 1970***Made - - - - 30th September 1970**Laid before Parliament 6th October 1970**Coming into Operation 1st March 1971*

The Board of Trade, in exercise of their powers under section 7(1) of the Civil Aviation (Licensing) Act 1960(a), as having effect by virtue of the Transfer of Functions (Civil Aviation) Order 1966(b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation (Aerial Advertising) (Amendment) Regulations 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st March 1971.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Civil Aviation (Aerial Advertising) Regulations 1961(d) shall be amended as follows:

In Regulation 3(2) for "three feet" there shall be substituted "one metre".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Civil Aviation (Aerial Advertising) Regulations 1961 by replacing the Imperial unit "three feet" in Regulation 3(2) by the approximate metric equivalent (one metre).
