The Tribunals and Inquiries (Lands Tribunal for Scotland) Order 1970

Made--29th September 1970Laid before Parliament12th October 1970Coming into Operation30th October 1970

We, the Lord Chancellor and the Secretary of State for Scotland, in exercise of the powers conferred on us by section 10(1) of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1958(a), and of all other powers enabling us in that behalf, hereby make the following order:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Tribunals and Inquiries (Lands Tribunal for Scotland) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 30th October 1970.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Part II of Schedule 1 to the Tribunal and Inquiries Act 1958 shall have effect as if there were specified therein the Lands Tribunal for Scotland constituted under section 1(1)(a) of the Lands Tribunal Act 1949(c).
