The Parliamentary Constituencies (Wales) Order 1970

Made - - - 11th November 1970 Coming into Operation 25th November 1970

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 11th day of November 1970

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas in pursuance of section 2(1) of the House of Commons (Redistribution of Seats) Act 1949(a) the Boundary Commission for Wales have submitted to the Secretary of State a report dated 19th May 1969, showing the constituencies into which they recommend, in accordance with the provisions of the House of Commons (Redistribution of Seats) Acts 1949 and 1958(b), that Wales should be divided:

And whereas the Secretary of State has laid the said report before Parliament together with the draft of this Order in Council to give effect to recommendations contained in the report and each House of Parliament has by resolution approved the said draft:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 3 of the House of Commons (Redistribution of Seats) Act 1949, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Parliamentary Constituencies (Wales) Order 1970.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (3) This Order shall come into operation on the fourteenth day after the day on which it is made:

Provided that the coming into operation of this Order shall not affect any parliamentary election until a proclamation is issued by Her Majesty summoning a new Parliament or affect the constitution of the House of Commons until the dissolution of the Parliament in being on the day on which this Order comes into operation.

- 2. In lieu of the constituencies described in Schedule 1 to the Representation of the People Act 1948(a) or in Orders made under the House of Commons (Redistribution of Seats) Act 1949, as the case may be, and specified in Part I of the Schedule to this Order there shall be substituted the constituencies described in Part II of the Schedule to this Order, the constituencies in the said Part II being described by reference to circumstances as they existed on 1st January 1969.
- 3. The electoral registration officers for the constituencies specified in the said Schedule shall make such re-arrangement or adaptation of the registers of parliamentary electors as may be necessary to give effect to this Order.
