The Gaming (Small Charges) Order 1970

Made - - - 3rd December 1970

Laid before Parliament 15th December 1970

Coming into Operation 1st January 1971

In pursuance of section 40(2) of the Gaming Act 1968(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Gaming (Small Charges) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1971.
 - (2) This Order shall not extend to Scotland.
- 2. A sum of 1s. 0d. (5p) is hereby specified for the purposes of section 40(2) of the Gaming Act 1968 (which permits a sum of sixpence, or such other sum as may be specified by order, to be charged for the right of a person to take part, on any one day, in gaming to which section 40 applies).
