The Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1970

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 27 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consulting the Police Council for Great Britain in accordance with section 26(8) of the said Act, I hereby make the following regulations :—

Citation and operation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1970.

Hours of duty

2. In paragraph (2) of regulation 5 of the Police Cadets (Scotland) Regulations 1968(b), as amended (c), (normal weekly period of duty) for the period "42 hours" there shall be substituted the period "40 hours".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Police Cadets (Scotland) Regulations 1968 and relate to a police cadet assigned to duties with a constable.

Regulation 2 provides that his normal weekly period of duty shall be 40 instead of 42 hours.
