REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE**The Elections (Welsh Forms) (No. 6) Regulations 1970**

Made - - - - - 10th June 1970
Coming into Operation 11th June 1970

In pursuance of the powers conferred on me by section 1(1) of the Elections (Welsh Forms) Act 1964(a), I hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Elections (Welsh Forms) (No. 6) Regulations 1970 and shall come into operation on 11th June 1970.

2. The Elections (Welsh Forms) Regulations 1964(b), the Elections (Welsh Forms) Regulations 1965(c), and the form numbered 1 set out in the Schedule to the Elections (Welsh Forms) Regulations 1969(d) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations revoke the Regulations specified in Regulation 2 of these Regulations. The revoked Regulations prescribe translations into the Welsh language of certain electoral forms.
