## COURT OF SESSION, SCOTLAND Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 1) 1970

Made - - - 23rd January 1970
Coming into Operation 3rd March 1970

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 16 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1933(a) and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, considering that it has been agreed by the Civil Service Department that certain fees payable to shorthand writers should be increased, do hereby enact and declare as follows:—

- 1. Rule 347 of the Rules of the Court of Session(b) as substituted by the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 1) 1966(c) shall be amended as follows:—
  - (a) Paragraphs 1 and 2 of Chapter IV—Table of Fees to Shorthand Writers, shall be deleted and in place thereof there shall be substituted the following:—
    - #1. Attending trials, proofs and commissions, per hour, with a minimum fee of £5 per day ...

      The above fees will be paid by the Exchequer.

      No fee will be paid where intimation of post-ponement or settlement is made by 4 p.m. on the previous day.
    - 2. Extending Notes, except when these are transcribed daily, per sheet of 250 words ... ... 0 7 3

      Extending Notes, when these are transcribed daily but not on stencils, per sheet of 250 words

      Extending Notes, when these are transcribed daily on stencils, per sheet of 250 words ... 0 11 0"
- 2. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 1) 1970 and shall come into operation on 3rd March 1970.
