# CINEMATOGRAPHS AND CINEMATOGRAPH FILMS EXHIBITION OF FILMS

## The Films (Exhibitors) (Amendment) Regulations 1970

Made - - - 2nd July 1970 Coming into Operation 1st August 1970

The Board of Trade, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section 44 of the Films Act 1960(a), as amended and extended by the Films Act 1970(b), and, so far as they prescribe fees, with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Films (Exhibitors) (Amendment) Regulations 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1970.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
  - 3. The Films (Exhibitors) Regulations 1961(d) shall have effect as if:
    - (1) for Regulation 1(4) there were substituted the following:—
    - "(4) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Regulation shall be in the case of a licence to be issued
      - (a) for a calendar year ... £10.
      - (b) for a quarterly period ... £3.
      - (c) for 2 quarterly periods ... £5 15s. 0d.
      - (d) for 3 quarterly periods ... £8 10s. 0d.";
  - (2) for Schedule 1 thereto there were substituted the Schedule to these Regulations;
  - (3) in Schedule 2, the words "except British films which do not count for quota" at the head of column (1) were omitted.

# **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Films (Exhibitors) Regulations 1961. The principal amendments are as follows:—

- (1) the fees payable in respect of applications for exhibitors' licences are increased; and
- (2) the form of application for an exhibitor's licence is amended to take account of the repeal by the Films Act 1970 of section 27 of the Film Act 1960 which related to circuit cinemas.
