REGISTRATION OF FILMS**

The Films (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 1970

<i>Made</i>	- - -	<i>2nd July 1970</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>		<i>16th July 1970</i>

The Board of Trade, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section 44 of the Films Act 1960(a), as amended and extended by the Films Act 1970(b), and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Films (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 1970 and shall come into operation on 16th July 1970.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Films (Registration) Regulations 1960(d), as amended (e), shall have effect as if:—

- (1) in Regulation 2(1), for “£300” there were substituted “£350” and for “£6 6s. 0d.” there were substituted “£10”;
- (2) in Regulation 2(2), for “£3 3s. 0d.” there were substituted “£4 15s. 0d.”;
- (3) in Regulation 10, for “1s. 6d.” there were substituted “3s. 0d.”;
- (4) in Regulation 11, for “7s. 6d.” there were substituted “12s. 0d.”.
