## **BETTING AND GAMING**

# The Gaming Clubs (Permitted Areas) (Scotland) Regulations 1971

Made - - - 15th September 1971
Laid before Parliament 28th September 1971
Coming into Operation 1st January 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 22(3) and 51 of the Gaming Act 1968(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with the Gaming Board for Great Britain, I hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Gaming Clubs (Permitted Areas) (Scotland) Regulations 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1972.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
  - (3) In these regulations, "the Act" means the Gaming Act 1968.
- 2.—(1) This regulation does not apply to licences to be granted or renewed subject to restrictions imposed under paragraph 25(1) of Schedule 2 to the Act limiting gaming (to which Part II of the Act applies) to bingo, bridge or whist or to both bridge and whist but, subject to that, it applies to all licences under the Act proposed to be granted or renewed.
- (2) A licensing authority shall refuse to grant or renew a licence to which this regulation applies where the licence is to be in respect of premises situated, wholly or in part, outside any county of a city.
- 3. Regulation 3 of and Schedule 1 to the Gaming Clubs (Licensing) (Scotland) Regulations 1969(c) are hereby revoked.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations make new provision in relation to the areas in Scotland in which licences for general gaming may be granted. The Regulations permit licences to be granted or renewed in any county of a city.
