

1971 No. 1636 (C.43)**CIVIL AVIATION****The Civil Aviation Act 1971 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1971**

Made - - - *7th October 1971*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 70(2) of the Civil Aviation Act 1971(a) hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Civil Aviation Act 1971 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1971.

2. Sections 37, 38(1)(f) (in so far as it relates to functions conferred on the British Airways Board by the enactments, other than that paragraph, brought into force by this Order), 41(1), (4) and (5), and 53(1)(a) of, and Schedule 8 to the Civil Aviation Act 1971 shall come into force on 7th October 1971.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force those provisions of the Civil Aviation Act 1971 which relate to the constitution of the British Airways Board and its power to borrow money temporarily and from the Air Corporations. The provisions now brought into force do not include any other powers of the Board in relation to the Corporations.
