**The Rate Support Grants (Pooling Arrangements) (Amendment)
Regulations 1971**

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred upon her by paragraph 13(2) of Schedule 1 to the Local Government Act 1966(a), hereby makes the following regulations—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Rate Support Grants (Pooling Arrangements) (Amendment) Regulations 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1971.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of Regulations

2. In regulation 2 of the Rate Support Grants (Pooling Arrangements) Regulations 1967(c) as amended (d) (ascertainment of expenditure of local education authorities)—

(a) the words “the limit prescribed by paragraph (3) below” shall be substituted for “£10,000” in paragraph (2); and

(b) there shall be added at the end as a new paragraph—

“(3) For the purposes of paragraph (2) the prescribed limit is, in the case of an establishment of further education designated by the Secretary of State as a Polytechnic, £50,000; and in respect of any other establishment of further education and any college or other institution for the training of teachers, £20,000.”
