The Jurors' Allowances (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1971*Made* - - - - *9th December 1971**Coming into Operation* *1st January 1972*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 24(1) and 32(1) of the Juries Act 1949(a), as amended by the Juries Act 1954(b), I hereby, with the consent of the Treasury, make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Jurors' Allowances (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1972.

2. In regulation 5 of the Jurors' Allowances (Scotland) Regulations 1971(c) (which relates to compensation for loss of earnings or additional expense) for the expressions of "£2·00", "£4·00" and "£8·00", there shall be substituted the expressions "£2·37½", "£4·75" and "£9·50" respectively.
