In pursuance of sections 22(3) and 51 of the Gaming Act 1968(a), and after consultation with the Gaming Board for Great Britain, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gaming Clubs (Permitted Areas) (Amendment) Regulations 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1972.

2. Paragraph (a) of Regulation 3 of the Gaming Clubs (Permitted Areas) Regulations 1971(b) shall be amended by substituting for the words "1st January 1971" the words "1st December 1970".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

The Gaming Clubs (Permitted Areas) Regulations 1971 permit licences for general gaming in any county borough outside Greater London having an estimated population, at any time from 1971 onwards, of 125,000 or more. These Regulations amend the earlier Regulations so as to take account for this purpose of the estimates published in December 1970.
