The Legal Aid (Scotland) (Extension of Proceedings)
Regulations 1971

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 1 and 15 of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1967(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid (Scotland) (Extension of Proceedings) Regulations 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st March 1971.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The proceedings in which legal aid may be given shall include proceedings before the Lands Tribunal for Scotland.
