- 1. This Order may be cited as the Building (Scotland) Act 1970 (Commencement) Order 1971.
- 2. The provisions of the Building (Scotland) Act 1970, other than those provisions of that Act which came into operation on the passing thereof, shall come into operation on 15th June 1971.
