**The Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2)
Regulations 1971**

<i>Made</i> - - -	14th May 1971
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	24th May 1971
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st June 1971

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 27 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967^(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consulting the Police Council for the United Kingdom in accordance with section 4(4) of the Police Act 1969^(b), I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1971.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Police Cadets (Scotland) Regulations 1968^(c), as amended^(d).

Operation and effect

3. These regulations shall come into operation on 1st June 1971 and shall have effect:—

- (a) for the purposes of regulation 4 thereof, as from 1st April 1971;
- (b) for the purposes of regulation 5 thereof, as from 1st June 1971.

Pay

4. For the Table in Schedule 1 to the principal regulations (which contains scales of pay) there shall be substituted the following Table:—

Charge for board and lodging

5. In Schedule 2 to the principal regulations (which relates to charges for board and lodging) there shall be substituted the sum of "£111" for the sum of "£105".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Police Cadets (Scotland) Regulations 1968.

Regulation 4 provides for increases in pay.

Regulation 5 increases charges for board and lodging by £6 a year.

By virtue of Regulation 3 the increases in pay have effect from 1st April 1971. This is provided in exercise of the power conferred by section 27(2) of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967.
