The Tribunals and Inquiries (Firemen's Pension Scheme Appeal Tribunals and Air Operators' Certificates) Order 1971

The Lord Chancellor and the Secretary of State for Scotland, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 10(1) and (3) of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1958(a), hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Tribunals and Inquiries (Firemen's Pension Scheme Appeal Tribunals and Air Operators' Certificates) Order 1971 and shall come into operation on 23rd June 1971.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3.—(1) Part I of Schedule 1 to the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1958 shall have effect as if there were specified therein—

- (a) appeal tribunals constituted in accordance with a scheme in force under section 26 of the Fire Services Act 1947(c) ; and
- (b) persons appointed under an Order in Council made in pursuance of section 8 of the Civil Aviation Act 1949(d) for the purpose of hearing appeals relating to Air Operators' Certificates.

(2) Section 9 of the said Act shall apply to the persons mentioned in paragraph (1)(b) above.

4. The Tribunals and Inquiries (Air Operators' Certificates) Order 1961(e) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings under the supervision of the Council on Tribunals appeal tribunals constituted in accordance with a pension scheme in force under the Fire Services Act 1947. It also brings under the supervision of the Council persons appointed under powers conferred by the Civil Aviation Act 1949 to hear appeals relating to Air Operators' Certificates and provides a right of appeal from such persons on a point of law.
