# The Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) (Amendment) Regulations 1972

Made 25th July 1972 Laid before Parliament 4th August 1972 Coming into Operation 1st September 1972

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of her powers under section 1 of the Education Act 1962(a), hereby makes the following regulations:-

#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) (Amendment) Regulations 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1972.
- (2) In these regulations "the principal regulations" means the Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) Regulations 1971(b).
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

#### **Definitions**

2. In the definition of the word "year" in regulation 2 of the principal regulations there shall be inserted after the word "means" the words "as regards any course".

## Members of religious orders

- 3. For paragraph (3) of regulation 19 of the principal regulations there shall be substituted-
  - "(3) The sum referred to in paragraphs (1) and (2) above is if the student resides at his parent's home or in a house of the order of which he is a member £195 if the student resides elsewherein the case of a student attending a course at the university of Oxford or Cambridge, at an establishment within the area comprising the City of London and the Metropolitan Police District or an institution outside the United Kingdom ... £265 in the case of a student attending a course elsewhere ... ... £245".

Suspension, etc. of payments

**4.** In paragraph (3) of regulation 24 of the principal regulations, after the word "is" there shall be inserted the words "in the case of a student in respect of whom apart from this paragraph a minimum payment would be payable, the appropriate proportion of the minimum payment, and in the case of any other student".

Requirements for maintenance, etc.

5. The provisions of schedule 1 to the principal regulations specified in the first column below shall have effect subject to the substitution for the amounts in the second column of the amounts in the third column.
