**The Southern Rhodesia (United Nations Sanctions)
 (Isle of Man) (Amendment) Order 1972**

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 1 of the United Nations Act 1946(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Southern Rhodesia (United Nations Sanctions) (Isle of Man) (Amendment) Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1973.

2. Article 14 of the Southern Rhodesia (United Nations Sanctions) (Isle of Man) Order 1969(b) and Schedule 1 thereto are hereby revoked.

 EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order revokes the provisions of the Southern Rhodesia (United Nations Sanctions) (Isle of Man) Order 1969 which authorise restrictions upon entry into the Isle of Man of certain persons connected with Southern Rhodesia. Those provisions refer to the Commonwealth Immigrants Act 1962 (c.21), which is repealed by the Immigration Act 1971 (c.77) (which itself is modified, in relation to certain persons so connected, by the Southern Rhodesia (Immigration Act 1971) Order 1972—S.I. 1972/1583). The present Order comes into operation on 1st January 1973, the date on which the Act of 1971 becomes fully operative.
