In column 3 of the Schedule to the Combined Probation and After-Care Areas Order 1972(b) (Secretary of Probation and After-Care Committee) for the words "The County Solicitor for East Suffolk" there shall be substituted the words "The Clerk and Chief Executive of the East Suffolk County Council".
