**The Rules of the Air and Air Traffic Control (Third Amendment)
Regulations 1972**

Made - - - 13th November 1972

Coming into Operation 12th December 1972

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under Article 61(1) of the Air Navigation Order 1972(a), as amended(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Rules of the Air and Air Traffic Control (Third Amendment) Regulations 1972 and shall come into operation on 12th December 1972.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) applies for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. In Rule 39(1) of the Schedule to the Rules of the Air and Air Traffic Control Regulations 1972(d) as amended(b), for "flight level 250" there shall be substituted "flight level 245".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Rules of the Air and Air Traffic Control Regulations 1972. The airspace to which the Special Rules for Air Traffic in the Upper Flight Information Regions apply is now the airspace from flight level 245 to flight level 460.
