The Legal Aid (Extension of Proceedings) Regulations 1972

Made - - - 8th November 1972

Laid before Parliament 16th November 1972

Coming into Operation 18th December 1972

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 1(3) and 12(1) of the Legal Aid and Advice Act 1949(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid (Extension of Proceedings) Regulations 1972 and shall come into operation on 18th December 1972.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. The proceedings in which legal aid may be given shall include proceedings before a Commons Commissioner appointed under section 17(1) of the Commons Registration Act 1965(c).
