## **NURSES AND MIDWIVES** The Central Midwives Board for Scotland (Variation) **Order 1972**

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made 13th December 1972

Coming into Operation 31st December 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1(3) and (4) of the Midwives (Scotland) Act 1951(a), and after consultation with such bodies and persons as appear to me to be concerned, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Central Midwives Board for Scotland (Variation) Order 1972, and shall come into operation on 31st December 1972.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The constitution of the Central Midwives Board for Scotland provided for in Schedule 1 of the Midwives (Scotland) Act 1951, as varied by the Central Midwives Board for Scotland (Reconstitution) Order 1952(c), shall be further varied as follows:-
  - (i) for any reference to the Scottish Committee of the British Medical Association there shall be substituted a reference to the Scottish Council of the British Medical Association,
  - (ii) for the reference to the Royal Faculty of Physicians and Surgeons, Glasgow there shall be substituted a reference to the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons, Glasgow,
  - (iii) for the reference to the Universities of Aberdeen, Edinburgh, Glasgow and St. Andrews there shall be substituted a reference to the Universities of Glasgow, Aberdeen, Edinburgh and Dundee.
