The Consular Fees (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1973

Made - - - - - 20th June 1973
Coming into Operation 11th July 1973

At the Court at Windsor Castle, the 20th day of June 1973

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 2(1) of the Consular Salaries and Fees Act 1891(a) and section 8(1) of the Fees (Increase) Act 1923(b), or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order shall come into operation on 11th July 1973 and may be cited as the Consular Fees (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1973.

2. Part II of the table of consular fees in the Schedule annexed to the Consular Fees Order 1971(c) as amended(d) is hereby amended by substituting for Fee 16 the following:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order fixes a fee for renewing for a further 5 years passports of 5 years' validity which were issued before the introduction of passports of 10 years' validity at the office of issue, and amends the Consular Fees Order 1971 accordingly.
